POTABLE (DRINKING) WATER RESTRICTIONS and WELL WATER and LAKE/POND WATER RESTRICTIONS

Changes Effective as of **May 9, 2012** as per SWFWMD
Modified Phase II Severe Water Shortage

Lawn and landscape watering is authorized for one-day-per-week.

If your address (house number) ends in...

...0 or 1, water only on Monday

...2 or 3, water only on Tuesday

...4 or 5, water only on Wednesday

...6 or 7, water only on Thursday

...8 or 9, water only on Friday

...And locations without a discernible address on Friday

Watering shall be accomplished before 8 a.m. or after 6 p.m. on allowable days.

Other general restrictions

- Follow applicable best management practices, including watering times and applications.
- Comply with all Water Use Permit conditions, including allowable drought quantities.
- Reduce off-site discharge and mobile equipment washing.
- Fountains and other aesthetic-only water features may only operate 4 hours per day. The regular hours of operation can be selected by the owner, but must be posted. Leaks should be promptly repaired.
- Car washing is limited to once per week on the designated watering day for the location. Fundraiser and commercial car washer, including mobile detailing businesses, may still operate on any day.
- Pressure washing for aesthetic purposes is allowed once on an annual basis. An automatic shutoff nozzle should be used on the hose. Pressure washing is allowed for necessary purposes such as prior to painting or sealing, in order to maintain a point or material warranty, to address a health or safety hazard, and to comply with health laws.

RECLAIMED WATER RESTRICTIONS

Effective April 20, 2012 to June 30, 2012

Applies to City of Pinellas Park reclaimed water users

In the City of Pinellas Park, **RECLAIMED WATER** may be used **2** days a week
based on the resident's home address

WATERING TIMES are limited to the hours of **4:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m.**

NO RECLAIMED WATER may be used during the daytime from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

NO RECLAIMED WATERING IS PERMITTED ON MONDAYS, THURSDAYS OR FRIDAYS!

If your house number ends in an even number (0,2,4,6,8), water on **TUESDAY AND SATURDAY**

If your house number ends in an odd number (1,3,5,7,9), water on **WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY**

If your property contains a mix of addresses or if an address cannot be determined, such as common areas associated with a residential subdivision, water on **WEDNESDAY AND SUNDAY**

***Non-compliance with any of these provisions (City Code Section 10-128)
may result in issuance of a Pinellas County Court Citation.***
