## POTABLE (DRINKING) WATER RESTRICTIONS

Effective April 3, 2009 – per SWFWMD Phase IV Order

**LAWN & LANDSCAPE WATERING SCHEDULE, using an in-ground irrigation system, is limited to ONE (1) DAY PER WEEK, AS FOLLOWS:**

| <u>Addresses/House Numbers Ending In</u>      | <u>May Water On</u> |
|---|---------------------|
| the number 0 or 1                             | Monday              |
| the number 2 or 3                             | Tuesday             |
| the number 4 or 5                             | Wednesday           |
| the number 6 or 7                             | Thursday            |
| the number 8 or 9                             | Friday              |
| mixed or no address, subdivision common areas | Friday              |

**WATERING TIMES, for locations of one (1) acre in size or less, ARE LIMITED TO:**  
**12:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m.**

**WATERING TIMES, for locations more than one (1) acre in size, ARE LIMITED TO:**  
**12:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m.                      and                      8:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.**

**NO WATERING is allowed on Saturdays and Sundays**

**NO RESIDENTIAL CAR WASHING is allowed**

**NO CHARITY CAR WASHES are allowed**

**NO PRESSURE CLEANING and NO STRUCTURE RINSING is allowed  
(unless performed by a commercial business for certain purposes)**

NOTE: Watering of lawns using a sprinkling can, hand-held hose equipped with automatic shut-off nozzle, or using a hose equipped with a portable sprinkler may also take place from 6-8 a.m. and 6-10pm. You may not use this watering method in combination with any other watering method.

NOTE: Watering of landscapes (non-lawn) using a sprinkling can, hand-held hose equipped with automatic shut-off nozzle, or micro-irrigation may also take place from 6-8 a.m. and 6-10 p.m. three (3) days a week (addresses ending in an even number on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday; addresses ending in an odd number on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday). You may not use this watering method in combination with any other watering method.

## WELL WATER and LAKE/POND WATER RESTRICTIONS

Effective December 2008 – per SWFWMD Phase III Order

**LAWN & LANDSCAPE WATERING SCHEDULE, using an in-ground irrigation system, is limited to ONE (1) DAY PER WEEK, as follows:**

**Addresses/House Numbers Ending In**

- the number 0 or 1
- the number 2 or 3
- the number 4 or 5
- the number 6 or 7
- the number 8 or 9
- mixed or no address, subdivision common areas

**May Water On**

- Monday
- Tuesday
- Wednesday
- Thursday
- Friday
- Friday

**WATERING TIMES are limited to only one (1) of the following time periods on your watering day:**

**12:01 a.m. to 7:59 a.m.**

**OR**

**6:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.**

**NO WATERING from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

**NO WATERING on Saturdays and Sundays**

HAND-WATERING/MICRO-IRRIGATION of plants (other than lawns), with a hand-held hose fitted with an automatic shut-off nozzle or a watering can or pail, can be done on any day, but only between the hours of 6:01 p.m. to 7:59 a.m.

NEW OR REPLACEMENT TURFGRASS (sod, plugs, seed, etc.) – there is a 30-day establishment period allowed. On days 1-15, watering may take place any day of the week – but NO WATERING is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. On days 16-30, watering may take place every other day (addresses ending with an even number may water only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday; addresses ending with an odd number may water only on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday) – NO WATERING is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

NEW PLANTS (other than lawns) – there is a 60-day establishment period allowed. On days 1-30, watering may take place any day of the week – but NO WATERING is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. On days 31-60, watering may take place every other day (addresses ending with an even number may water only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday; addresses ending with an odd-number may water only on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday) – NO WATERING is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

## RECLAIMED WATER RESTRICTIONS

Applies to City of Pinellas Park reclaimed water users

**In the City of Pinellas Park, RECLAIMED WATER may be used 7 days a week**

**WATERING TIMES are limited to 4:01 p.m. to 9:59 a.m.**

**NO RECLAIMED WATER may be used from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

***Non-compliance with any of these provisions (City Code Section 10-128) may result in issuance of a Pinellas County Court Citation.***
