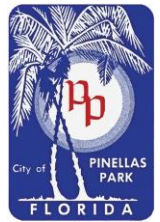

ESTIMATED BUILDING PERMIT FEES

Other than One & Two Family Dwelling

Fee Schedule for Building and Engineering Permits:

Table with 2 columns: Fee Range and Fee Amount. Rows include: \$1,000.00 or less = \$50.00; \$1,000.00 to \$50,000.00 = \$50.00 for the first \$1,000 + \$7 for each additional \$1,000; \$50,001.00 to \$500,000.00 = \$393.00 for the first \$50,000 + \$6 for each additional \$1,000.00; \$500,001.00 & OVER = \$3,093.00 for the first \$500,000 + \$3 for each additional \$1,000.00

PERMIT

- BUILDING: use Valuation of work and fee schedule above to calculate fee
ENGINEERING (site work): use Valuation of Engineering work and fee schedule above to calculate fee
LANDSCAPE: use Acreage x \$40.00 per Acre
ELECTRICAL: use SF of work area x \$0.04 or \$50.00 minimum
PLUMBING: use SF of work area x \$0.04 x \$50.00 minimum
MECHANICAL: use SF of work area x \$0.04 or \$50.00 minimum
FIRE LIFE SAFETY: use SF of work area x \$0.05 or \$50.00 minimum
If SF of work area is less than 1,250 SF, the \$50.00 fee applies

PLAN REVIEW FEES: (Amount to be paid upon submittal) (_____)

Plan review fees are 50% of the Subtotal above or a minimum of \$50.00 for other than 1 & 2 Family Residential.

TECHNOLOGY FEES:

Add Technology fees as calculated below for EACH permit listed above
Permit fee of \$50.00 = \$2.00; \$50.01 - \$100.00 = \$5.00; \$100.01 - \$1000.00 = \$10.00;
over \$1000.00 = \$20.00

TOTAL ESTIMATED BUILDING PERMIT FEES

This form is used to calculate the estimated plan review fees per Section 18-905 of the City of Pinellas Park Land Development Code. The estimated plan review fees are due at the time plans are submitted to the City for review.

Note: There may be other fees that apply to your project, including the following items:

- *There are fees for new water meters, sewer taps, and for commercial projects, backflow devices.
*New buildings or new interior buildouts may have Transportation Impact Fees due.
*There are also fees for Fire Alarms and Fire Sprinklers.
