W1 HOMELESS SERVICES PROPOSED SYSTEM REDESIGN

Dr. Robert Marbut, founding CEO of Haven for Hope in San Antonio, Texas, will present for discussion the experience of the Haven for Hope project and his current project as a consultant to the City of St. Petersburg to address homeless issues. Dr. Marbut's presentation will address his scope of work in St. Petersburg and Pinellas County, describe efforts to date to review and redesign homeless services systems, and discuss the newly proposed site, Annex 2 on 49th Street North, as a homeless shelter/courtyard.

III. GENERAL BUSINESS
