

## Frequently Asked Questions

Where are the **UNIVERSITY OF PINELLAS PARK (UPP) sessions held?**

UPP sessions are held at various City buildings such as City Hall at 5141 78th Avenue and Park Station at 5851 Park Boulevard.

**How do I apply for the UPP?**

If you are interested in being a UPP participant, submit an application to the Community Development Department. Brochures like this one which include an application form, are available at City Hall, Park Station and the Pinellas Park Library, or may be downloaded from the City's website at [www.pinellas-park.com](http://www.pinellas-park.com).

**What should I wear to UPP sessions?**

UPP sessions are informal. As meeting rooms tend to be cool, a light jacket or sweater is suggested. Some sessions may include tours and/or interactive exercises, so participants are encouraged to dress comfortably and wear comfortable shoes.

**May I bring a guest to UPP sessions?**

Because of space limitations participants may not bring guests to the UPP sessions, however guests are welcome to attend the UPP Graduation held at City Hall.

**What should I do after I graduate from the UPP?**

The City encourages participants to use knowledge gained from the UPP to apply for open positions on any of the City's Volunteer Boards and Commissions and/or to offer assistance to the various City Departments for future City events, programs and projects.
